

Ten Tips for Attaining Serenity

- 1) Keep count. Keep a written record of every fear that passes through your mind during the week, read over the list of the worries and find out how many of your worries came true. You will find that hardly any really come true.
- 2) Learn to separate between the things you cannot control. Ask yourself if the situation is one you can control. If it is not, give up the worry.
- 3) Stop it early. Once worry gets a tight grip; it can last for hours, even days or weeks. So, the moment you first notice that dark cloud intruding your thoughts, cut it off. Change your physical state-run up and down the stairs. Get into some activities.
- 4) Schedule time to brood. Set aside 20 or 30 minutes each day to do nothing but think. By limiting worrying to one time slot, you will be able to free up the rest of your day.
- 5) Turn off negativity. Since worry is future oriented, focus on the present. Deliberately think about positive things. "It is never as bad, I think. "I can handle whatever happens.
- 6) Get the facts. Don't trust the rumors. Knowledge is power, so gain as much information as possible about the situation.
- 7) Talk things out. Confront the matter. Talking to your spouse, siblings or trusted friends about your concern might help.
- 8) Ask yourself "so what?" What if I lose my job? What if I gain ten pounds? What if my son failed in math? Would I be a failure as a mother or father?
- 9) Make a list of options and make a decision. Rehearse the possibilities, and just run with the one that is the best of the bunch.
- 10) Seek professional help. God is the chief physician. He has the final answer. When all doors seem to be closed, God opens another door.

Let us make this prayer everyday as we get up: "Lord, help me to remember that nothing is going to happen to me today that you and I together cannot handle"!


