


Tips to Attain Serenity

No one is forced to worry, but still, everyone worries. How to stop worrying? Just as we can train our muscles to learn a new golf or tennis swing, we can train our brains to learn new ways of dealing with worries. Following are a few tips:

- * Keep count: Keep a written record of every fear that passes through your mind during the week, read over the list of the worries and find out how many of your worries actually came true. Remember Mark Twain's remark, "I have known a great many troubles, but most of them never happened."
- * Ask yourself "So what?" What if I lose my job? What if I gain 10 pounds? What if my son failed in math? What if I failed in a couple of subjects in school, would I be a failure?"
- * Stop it early: Once the worry gets a tight grip; it can last for hours, even days and weeks. So the moment you first notice that dark cloud intruding in your thoughts cut it off. Change your physical state-run up and down the stairs, splash cold water on your face, or maw the lawn.
- * Turn off negativity: Since worry is future-oriented, focus on the present. Deliberately think about positive things. "it is never as bad as I think." "I can handle whatever happens."
- * Talk things out. Confront the matter. Talking to your spouse, sibling, or trusted friends about your concern might help.
- * Learn to separate between the things you can and cannot control. Ask yourself if the situation is one you can control. If it is not, give up the worry and leave it to God.


YOUTH FORMATION REGISTRATION




