



## Meaning and significance of Advent

This week we are starting the season of Advent. This is a special season to prepare for the birth of Christ. Like Lent, this season also calls for spending more time in prayer and other acts of penance to prepare our hearts to welcome the baby Jesus into our hearts. The word **Advent** means "coming" or "arrival." . Our worship, scripture readings, and prayers not only prepare us spiritually for Christmas (his first coming), but also for his eventual second coming. This is why the Scripture readings during Advent include both Old Testament passages related to the expected Messiah, and New Testament passages concerning Jesus' second coming as judge of all people. Also, passages about John the Baptist, the precursor who prepared the way for the Messiah, are read.

During Advent we wait prayerfully and patiently in the manner of our Lord and his blessed Mother. It is not only a good spiritual discipline, but could also will lower our risk of holiday-induced blood pressure. Both the season of Advent and the season of Lent are about hope. It is not just hope for a better day or hope for the lessening of pain and suffering, although that is certainly a significant part of it. It is more about hope that human existence has meaning and possibility beyond our present experiences, a hope that the limits of our lives are not nearly as narrow as we experience them to be. It is not that we have possibility in ourselves, but that God is a God of new things and so all things are possible.

Advent's intention is to awaken the most profound and basic emotional memory within us, namely, the memory of the God who became a child. This is a healing memory; it brings hope. The purpose of the Church's year is continually to rehearse her great history of memories, to awaken the heart's memory so that it can discern the star of hope....
