

- Wednesday, Nov. 1st: All Saints Day is a holy day of obligation. Mass will be held at 4:30 p.m., outside, with the blessing of St. Joseph Cemetery. Mass at 6:30 p.m. will be held in the church. There will be no morning Mass on Wednesday.
- 3. Thursday, Nov. 2nd: 8:30 a.m. Daily Mass. Memorial Mass will be held at 6 p.m. The Memorial Mass is for the families of those who have passed within the last year. #### **CEMETERY GUIDELINES**

- The Diocesan Guidelines state, that there is to be no pressure washing in the cemetery between the dates of October 15th & November 5th of every year.
- No glass vases, pots, or containers are permitted on the floors inside or outside of the mausoleums or on walkways except at the funeral time.
   They should be removed within a few days after the funeral.
- 3. Planting of trees & shrubs is prohibited.


