Reasons to be Joyful

- 1. Look for what is right rather than what is wrong. When you wake up in the morning you can immediately find at least 5 things that are right in your world. You have food, water, clothes and shelter. Your car runs, you have gas, family, friends, and freedom. You have no reason to be unhappy.
- 2. Look to God and live your own life. Find your passion and purpose. Look for mentors. Stay true to yourself.
- 3. *Enjoy your journey*. In every difficulty or failure in life, there is a lesson and an opportunity. Look for the lesson and learn from it. Life is precious and doesn't have to be difficult. Find joy in everything. Sceneries are on the way, not at the end of the journey.
- 4. *Be silly, laugh, and have fun.* Hang out with people who bring out best in you. Seriousness and intensity can steal your joy and cause anxiety. Turn off electronics and practice relaxation and meditation.
- 5. Love everyone. You never know what kind of personal war anyone is going through. Send blessings to people who are hurting, or in pain. We all want the same three things: to give love, to receive love and know that we matter. Know you are loved; there is no greater joy than this.
- 6. Be generous. You have reached the pinnacle of success as soon as you become uninterested in money, complements, or publicity. Give of your time, talent, and resources. Go the extra mile. Give praise. Live to give. Build someone's future
- 7. *Be kind to yourself.* Think well of yourself. See yourself with a loving heart and compassionate eyes. When you make a mistake, forgive yourself immediately.
- 8. Spend money wisely. The man is the richest whose pleasures are the cheapest. Choose to use less, save more and appreciate everything you own. Create a budget and stick to it. Only purchase what you need. If we use only what we need there would be enough resources for everyone.

We can be joyful in the midst of suffering and turmoil so long as we are close to Christ. This is the secret of the saints. They reached such a degree of closeness to their friend Jesus that sufferings only increased their joy because it made it easier for them to identify with him.




