Bible Verses About Easter and the Resurrection of Jesus

- We celebrate Easter because this holiday recognizes that we can die to our old way of living and resurrect into our new life with Christ. Christianity does require a death to self. But the resurrection we experience in a spiritual sense and the resurrection of the body we have yet to experience give us ample cause for celebration. (Jesus said to Martha, "I am the resurrection and life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live." -John11:25)
- We have full confidence that no matter what happens to us on this Earth we can experience eternal joy with God in heaven. No wonder many brothers and sisters continue praising Jesus even when they experience persecution and martyrdom. Because we have a greater hope and promise than earthly life. It is integral to our faith that we believe in the Resurrection. Our faith has no foundation if we don't believe Jesus rose again on that Easter Sunday. ("If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you." -Romans 8:11)
- The Christian faith has many symbols. We often replicate the process Jesus underwent on the cross in a symbolic sense. We die to our old selves. We also are "buried" through the sacrament of baptism and experience a resurrection and new life in Christ. Christ gives us a new life holistically. We experience some of that new life during our time on Earth and look forward to experiencing the rest of the resurrection in Heaven. ("For to this end Christ died and lived again, that he might be Lord of the dead and of the living." -Romans 14:9)
- We celebrate Easter because God lived the life we should've lived and died the death we deserved to die so that we could live. What a wonderful cause for celebration That we can experience the resurrection with Him! ("We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that ,just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." -Romans 6:4)
