Labor Day Reflections

Church teachings remind us of the value of work: among other things, work enhances our human dignity, it is needed in order to form and maintain a family, and it contributes to the common good of our local, national, and global communities. Yet we all know the difficulties and challenges that work can bring, especially the need to balance time spent at work with time spent at home with their families, and honoring God. This Labor Day, let us reflect on the value of work and on how we recognize and respect the dignity of all workers.


